In order to proceed in the second year of the School of Pharmacy curriculum, you must be licensed as a Pharmacy Intern by the Texas State Board of Pharmacy. Licensure is obtained after completion of 30 hours of course work. The Texas State Board of Pharmacy conducts a background check with the Texas Department of Public Safety for violations which include drug and alcohol related offenses, professional disciplinary actions, felony or misdemeanor convictions, and court ordered probation or confinement. Without licensure, you will be unable to complete the curriculum.
