Your responsibility: To check your registration for accuracy! 3.



### Fall Registration - Your Personal Responsibility

It is **YOUR** responsibility to double check your registration to ensure you are in the required courses and labs to meet graduation requirements.

If you have a HOLD on your account, you will not be registered so make sure you take care of any holds before June 1. You can check your WebRaider account to view holds (click on the current term), determine what it is for and who placed the hold.





### **Examples of Possible Holds**

- Missing Immunizations:
  - TB Skin Test or symptom screen. This will be provided on your campus and is required every May.
  - May also include Tdap Booster, CPR, etc.
- Account Balance Due
- Parking Citations

Holds will prevent you from being registered!



### **Class Schedule**

### **Class Schedule Continued**

- The Class Schedule is posted on the school website at www.ttuhsc.edu/pharmacy/academics/ (2022-2023/ Fall 2022/Class Schedule). It allows you to see the days and times for each course.
- Enroll in course sections for 1 campus only:
  - Abilene: 021 (LABS: 521, 523, 525, etc...)
