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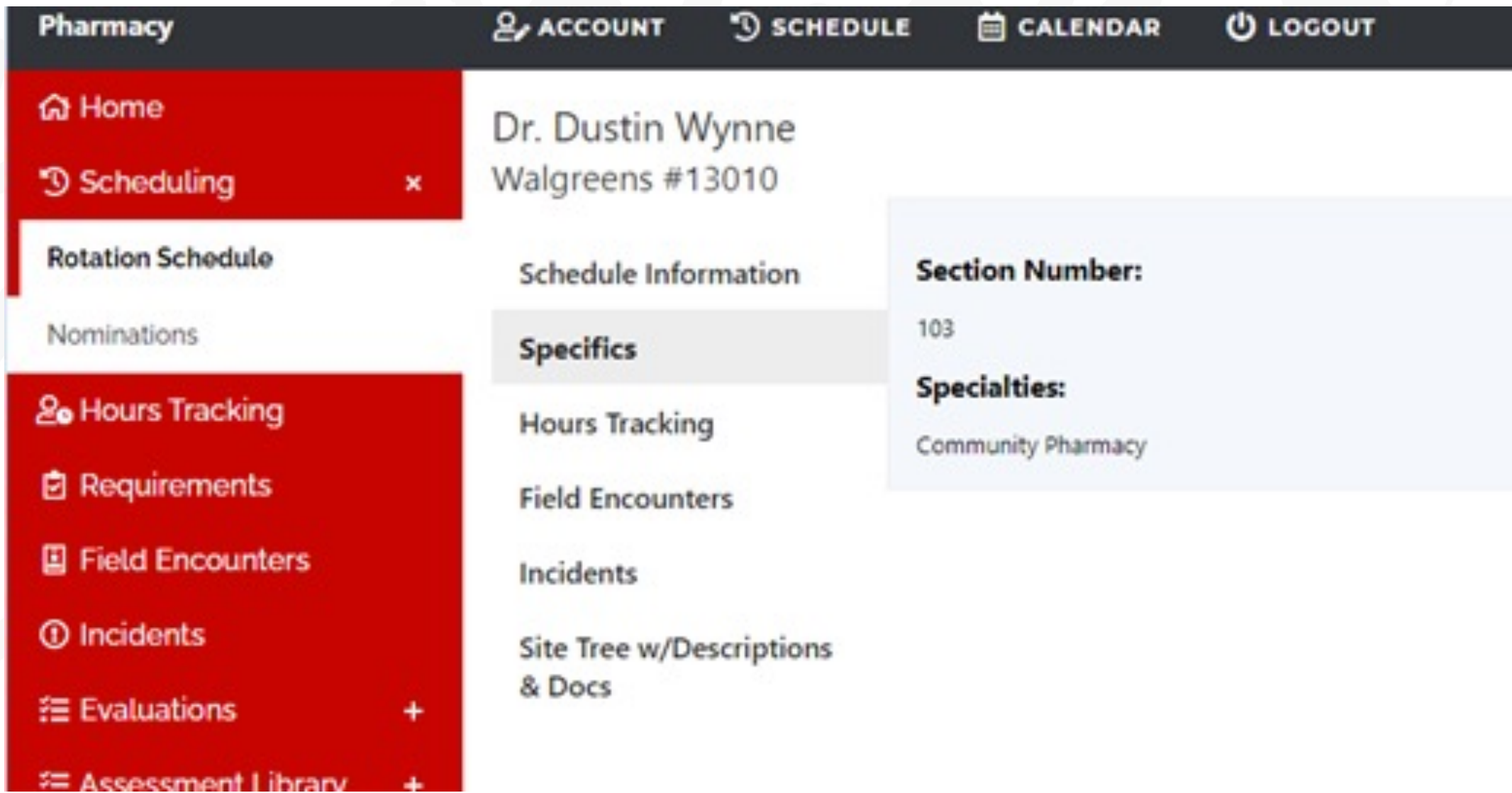

Registration – Important Info!

- The SOP will mass load your fall registration. (Summer has already been added.)
- It is **YOUR** responsibility to double check your registration. Use the Enrollment Sheet as a guide and look at your Degree Works audit to make sure you have Fall courses, rotations, and electives.
- It is your responsibility to check your registration and notify Allison, Josh, or Lisa if there is an error.
- If you have a **HOLD** on your account, your registration will not run. You can check your WebRaider account to view holds (click on the current term), determine what it is for and who placed the hold. **Make sure you get holds removed by early June.**



Examples of Possible Holds

- Missing Immunizations
 - **TB Skin Test or symptom screen.** This should be provided on your campus so please participate. This is required every May to satisfy preceptor sites/contracts. It is not optional.
 - May also include renewed CPR, Tdap Booster, etc.
- Advisor requirements from other schools – Rawls College of Business or Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences
- Account Balance Due from Student Business Services

Holds will prevent you from being registered!
