

Journal Articles

The Library has journals in either full-text, electronic format or in paper format, depending on the specific title and the publication date.

There are 2 main approaches to finding journal articles in the Library:

- **BY SUBJECT**: To compile a list of articles on a specific subject, use one of the many databases we have, such as *PubMed, OVID or MD Consult*. As a convenience, most of our databases have links to the full-text of at least some of the articles this is not a complete linking to our electronic journals, but can be an efficient way to get to some of the full-text articles you need.
- **BY JOURNAL TITLE:** If you have the name of a specific journal that you want to look for (either a specific article that you need or if you want to browse a journal), use one of the following resources:
 - GOLD RUSH is where you search, by journal title, to see if the Libraries own a specific journal. If we do, Gold Rush is the best, most comprehensive place to get links to our full-text, electronic journal subscriptions. These links are listed toward the bottom of the journal title information, under the heading "Full Text Resources Online." Pay attention to the details under "Dates Available" this shows the years we have available electronically.
 - ONLINE CATALOG gives details on those journals owned, in paper copy, in the 4 TTUHSC libraries. If you need a copy of an article from one of the other locations, you may request it through our Interlibrary Loan service and we will get it for you.
