Student Health Insurance - Two Options

- 1. Enroll in the Student Health Insurance Plan
- Facilitated by Academic Health Plans (AHP)
- Coverage January 1 August 31, 2022
- 2. Submit Waiver for Student Health Insurance Plan
 - If you Already Have Health Insurance
 - Has to be Affordable Care Act (ACA) Compliant
 - Has to be currently active



Student Health Insurance - Waiver Approved for Fall 2021

Make changes (if needed) November 1, 2021 - January 31, 2022.

- If your waiver was approved for Fall 2021, you do NOT have to submit another waiver for Spring/Summer 2022.
- You will have to submit a waiver for Fall 2022.
- There will be periodic checks (audits) to make sure your insurance is still active.
- It will be your responsibility to ensure you maintain health insurance coverage for the duration of the spring and summer semesters (January 1, 2022-August 31, 2022).

Student Health Insurance - Utilized School Insurance Fall 2021

Make changes (if needed) November 1, 2021 - January 31, 2022.

- You will be charged the Student Health Insurance Spring/Summer 2022 Premium on your Tuition
 & Fee account once you are registered for classes.
- All you need to do is pay it by the deadline (December 29, 2021) to avoid a \$25 penalty.
- Insurance coverage is from January 1 August 31, 2022. You will be able to access your health insurance benefits and request your insurance card on the <u>AHP website</u> starting Jan 1st.

- Your premium is NOT automatically paid by Financial Aid. You must go into the system and pay.

Spring Registration - Your Personal Responsibility

- It is YOUR responsibility to enroll in the required courses to meet graduation requirements.
- You may change your schedule at any time prior to the first day of the spring semester January 3, 2022. Once the semester begins, any changes must be submitted to Student Affairs, who will then authorize the Registrar to make the changes in the schedule. THERE WILL BE A FEE (\$50 \$75).
- If you have a HOLD on your account, you will not be able to register. You can check your WebRaider account to view holds (click on the current term), determine what it is for and who placed the hold.

Examples of Possible Holds

- Missing Immunizations (Flu vaccine was due October 31, 2021).
 Can also include Tdap Booster, CPR, etc.
- Missing Final Transcripts From Your Undergraduate Institution
- Account Balance Due

Holds will prevent you from registering!



Common Errors when Registering

- Wrong Course
- Wrong Section
- Wrong Campus
- Enrolling for a lecture without enrolling for the lab, etc.

After you have registered, you are required to send an electronic copy (screen shot is fine) of your Concise Student Schedule from the WebRaider Portal to Student Affairs.

Class Schedule

- Use the Spring Enrollment Sheet provided to you, which includes the CRN's for every course. You will receive the enrollment sheets soon.
- By following this sheet, your schedule should be accurate.

Class Schedule Continued

- The Class Schedule is posted on the school website under Academic Information. Visit www.ttuhsc.edu/pharmacy/academics/ (2021-2022/ Spring 2022/Class Schedule) to see the days and times for each course.
- Enroll in course sections for 1 campus only:
 - Abilene: 021 Lectures, (LABS: 521, 523, 525, etc...)
 - Amarillo: 001 Lectures, (LABS: 501, 503, 505, etc...)
 - Dallas: 041 Lectures, (LABS: 541, 543, 545, etc...)
- Check your Concise Student Schedule if it shows more than one campus, then you have registered incorrectly.



How to Register from WebRaider Portal


- 1. Log-in to raiderlink.ttu.edu using your eraider username and password.
- 2. Click on TTU MyTech tab on the left.
- 3. Under Registration and Financials, go to Manage My Enrollment, then click on Registration.
- 4. Select Add or Drop Classes. This will take you to Banner.
- 5. Click on Register for Classes.
- 6. From the drop-down box, select Spring 2022 Pharmacy.
- 7. Select the Enter CRN tab, and enter the CRNs of the classes you wish to take.
- 8. When you find the section you want, click on Add.



Once you select the section that you want to enroll in, you will notice that it has been placed in your Calendar View and in the Summary View. Since it has not been submitted, the course will be shaded.



Once you submit your request, the course in the Calendar View and in the summary will change to a solid color. You will also notice that the status in the summary will state "Registered".



Once you have submitted your enrollment, a confirmation email will be sent to your TTUHSC email account.

Register by December 8, 2021; 5 p.m.

- This may seem early, but we want all of the processes to work smoothly.
- When you register, Student Business Services processes and sends you an ebill.
- Then, Financial Aid has a bill (tuition and fees) to process your Financial Aid award for the Spring semester, if you qualify.
- If you wait until after December 9th to register, this process will be very late.

Student Business Services - Financial Aid Info

- Financial Aid will apply to accounts beginning on 12/27/2021 if you utilize FA. Financial aid will be applied towards any outstanding tuition and fee balances. Late payment charges will not be applied to any accounts until after the first financial aid disbursement on 12/27/2021.
- Tuition and Fee Payment Deadlines
 - 100% Due 12/29/2021
 - Payment Plan due dates:
 - 50% Due 12/29/2021
 - 25% Due 01/28/2022
 - 25% Due 03/09/2022
 - Students who elect this option will be assessed a \$25 billing fee on the first installment due on 12/29/2021.
- If you do not have an approved Student Health Insurance Waiver, the insurance fee will not by automatically paid by Financial Aid. You must go in and pay by 12/29/2021 to avoid a \$25 late fee.


