## **Reference Management Software**

Reference Management Software can be use to organize journal references when you are preparing a presentation or manuscript. Through the Libraries' web site you have access to two programs: RefWorks and EndNote.

Both RefWorks and EndNote are available through the Libraries' webpage (<u>www.ttuhsc.edu/libraries</u>), under "Library Services / Bibliographic Tools."

- **REFWORKS** is a web-based reference manager, which means that you can save and organize your references and have access to them from any computer that has internet access. RefWorks allows direct import of references from databases such as PubMed and Ovid and allows you to organize references into folders. By installing a small "utility file" (called Write and Cite) within Word, you have the ability to insert your RefWorks references directly into your manuscript and have the reference lists correctly and automatically formatted within your Word document.
- **ENDNOTE** can be used as either a web-based or a more complete installed version. If you are interested in installing EndNote on your computer, come talk to the Library, as we have EndNote CDs for installation. The web-based version can be accessed through the ISI Web of Knowledge database, available from the Libraries' database listing. Similarly to RefWorks, EndNote allows direct import of references from databases such as PubMed and Ovid, allows you to organize references into folders and can be used within Word for correctly formatting references within a manuscript.
