

Guidelines for Pharm Sci Research Methods - Lab Rotation Credit

1. All incoming students must register for one (1) term in Pharmaceutical Science Research Methods immediately upon matriculation.
2. No permanent lab assignments will be made until completion of one term of Pharmaceutical Science Research Methods (lab rotation).
3. Research Methods for Ph.D. students will count as an elective course toward their didactic credit requirement. Research Methods for Master students will count toward the research requirement of their degree. (Master students must take 24 hours of Core Curriculum. No electives count toward their 24 hour requirement)
4. Students who have not been accepted into a lab by the end of their first rotation must register for Pharmaceutical Sciences Research (not Research Methods) for any additional lab rotations needed.
5. Additional didactic credit for Research Methods will only be allowed for training outside a student's assigned lab. The student's major advisor must submit a written request to the Graduate Program Advisor requesting that the student be allowed to take a Research Methods course in another lab to learn techniques complementary to their research. Only one rotation outside the lab for additional credit will be allowed.
6. Unauthorized enrollment for more than one term of Research Methods will be applied toward the student's research requirement and not toward the elective didactic requirement.
