

## TTUHSC Total Enrollment Fall 2007-2016




\* TTUHSC at El Paso became a separate institution beginning in Fall 2013 and is excluded from the enrollment count from that point

## New FLSA Ruling Impact

- For most employees, the minimum salary level required for exemption is \$913 per week
- Must be paid “free and clear”
- The \$913 per week may be paid in equivalent amounts for periods longer than one week:

– Biweekly:	\$1,826
– Semimonthly:	\$1,978.16
– Monthly:	\$3,956.33
– Annual:	\$47,475.96

*Potential annual financial impact to TTUHSC: \$1 million*

## Injunction Placed by Federal Judge on New Overtime Pay Executive Order

- For most employees, the minimum salary level required for exemption is \$913 per week
- Must be paid “free and clear”
- The \$913 per week may be paid in equivalent amounts for periods longer than one week:
  - **Biweekly:** \$1,826
  - **Semimonthly:** \$1,978.16
  - **Monthly:** \$3,956.33

## Institutional Collaborations Update



1. A Memorandum of Understanding has been developed between TTU and TTUHSC for joint faculty appointments to enhance research and academic activities at both institutions.
2. A grant proposal for submission to the Defense Advanced Research Project Agency (DARPA), an agency of the Department of Defense, is being developed by ASU, TTU and TTUHSC to explore disease surveillance and animal health, specifically:
  - Point of Care Detection (animal health, human health, biosecurity)
  - Interventions
  - Disruptive innovative technology development for detection of chemical or biological hazards for animal and human health and biosecurity.




