New Online Reporting Form for Positive COVID-19 Tests

If you are exposed to or test positive for COVID-19, follow the current isolation and quarantine protocols outlined on the <u>TTUHSC SAFE Self-Monitoring & Reporting website</u>. Under these protocols, all students and team members who test positive for COVID-19 must report their diagnosis to the Office of Institutional Health through the <u>online reporting form</u>. This new online reporting form replaces the previous attestation form used by the Office ofInstitutional Health.

Upon submission of a COVID-19 positive test report, you will be provided an email outlining isolation start and end dates as well as additional resources. Please note that the Office of Institutional Health will not directly reach out to you regarding the report you submitted.

As a trusted member of the TTUHSC community, we each have a responsibility to do our part to protect the well-being of ourselves and those we serve. I truly appreciate your continued support and adherence to this reporting protocol.
