Prerequisites for Being Involved in Human Subject Research

The TTUHSC HRPP requires **all** research study personnel who engage in human subjects research to complete the TTUHSC approved initial (and ongoing) education regarding the protection of human subjects in research **prior to** beginning any human research-related activities. **This policy applies to all research involving human subjects, regardless of funding or sponsorship.**

ALL RESEARCH STUDY PERSONNEL ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO:

- [Have/maintain an active Cayuse account](#)

These training requirements apply to all Principal Investigators, Co-Investigators, and research staff. This includes individuals who:

- Conduct study procedures (including informed consent) or interventions with human subjects;
- Review Board Members;
- Collect or enter data; **and/or**
- Use or have access to private information that can be linked to research subjects.

Failure to Comply

The IRB has the authority to **suspend or withhold approval** from any project that involves study personnel who fail to meet these education requirements.

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
