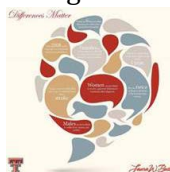




Bush Institute for Women's Health grant program provides seed money to fund novel research unique to women's health that highlights critical issues for women or focuses on the sex and gender differences in etiology, symptomatology and treatment of medical conditions that lead to more personalized medical care.</p> <p><b>Eligible:</b> Researchers submitting grants from any Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School will use the existing grant application process and deadline within their School.
