

# DIY HOMEMADE MASKS

## *community donations*

tutorial from the Turban Project

### *materials.*

- Heavy, Tightly woven cotton fabric. Must be 100% cotton (*Cotton duck cloth is recommended*)
- Elastic Rope; Beading cord elastic is perfect.
- Cut the rope 7in long and tie a knot in each end. DO NOT knot ends of the flat.

### *Instructions:*

**Step 1:** Put right sides of cotton fabric together and cut

- Sizes: 9x6 for Adult or 7.5x5 for Child

**Step 2:** Starting at the center of the bottom edge sew to the first corner and stop. Sew the elastic with the knot into the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this. Leave one side of elastic out.

**Step 3:** Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.

**Step 4:** Sew across the top of the mask to the next corner. Leaving one side out, sew a side of the elastic to the corner.

**Step 5:** Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner and sew.

**Step 6:** Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5" to 2" open. Stop, cut the thread and turn the mask inside out.

**Step 7:** Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure they are in the same direction.

**Step 8:** Sew around the edges of the mask twice.

*Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally*
