#### tutorial from the Turban Project

### materials.

- Heavy, Tightly woven cotton fabric. Must be 100% cotton (Cotton duck cloth is recommended)
- Elastic Rope; Beading cord elastic is perfect.
- Cut the rope 7in long and tie a knot in each end. DO NOT knot ends of the flat.

## Instructions:

- Step 1: Put right sides of cotton fabric together and cut
  - Sizes: 9x6 for Adult or 7.5x5 for Child
- **Step 2:** Starting at the center of the bottom edge sew to the first corner and stop. Sew the elastic with the knot into the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this. Leave one side of elastic out.
- **Step 3:** Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
- **Step 4:** Sew across the top of the mask to the next corner. Leaving one side out, sew a side of the elastic to the corner.
- **Step 5:** Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner and sew.
- **Step 6:** Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5" to 2" open. Stop, cut the thread and turn the mask inside out.
- **Step 7:** Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure they are in the same direction.
- **Step 8:** Sew around the edges of the mask twice.

Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally
