

STUDENT MEDICAL BENEFIT

TTUHSC Abilene



As part of your student medical benefit, you can receive care at the Abilene Community Health Center (ACHC) for acute medical conditions, free of charge. ACHC is located across the street from TTUHSC Abilene, at 1749 Pine St.

Hours of operation are M - F, 8 am - 12 pm and 1 - 5 pm; third Saturdays 8 am - 1 pm

WHAT IS COVERED

The benefit includes care for acute medical conditions and symptoms such as:

- Strep throat
- Flu
- Infections (sinus, upper respiratory, etc.)
- Fever/ Vomiting

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

The benefit does not include coverage of the following:

- Annual physical exam
- Vaccinations or immunizations
- Care for chronic conditions, such as diabetes
- Other non-acute medical situations

Note: You may visit ACHC for routine (non-acute) health care needs as well; however, the clinic will file an insurance claim for the visit, and an associated co-pay will be required. Sliding fee discount program is available for those who qualify.

HOW TO BE SEEN AT ACHC

1. During Hours of Operation, call 325-696-0600 to make an appointment; you may also walk in.
2. Identify yourself as a TTUHSC student, and be prepared to show your TTUHSC student badge and State Identification card (Driver License or ID card).
3. If it is possible, same day appointment will be provided.
4. Be prepared to access and share health documentation from other providers, such as you would find on a personal health portal.
5. Office visit and associated testing/lab costs will be provided free of charge.
