Casino Night (Amarillo)

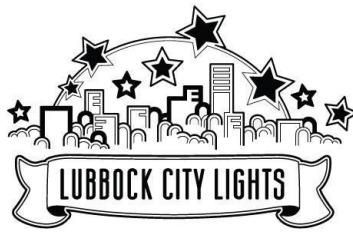
