Register today for 2020 Spring IPE Day brought to you by the Office of Interprofessional Education at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center. Spring IPE Day is an excellent way to learn together and practice interprofessional education, teamwork, and collaboration among health care professionals.

Spring IPE Day is a fun-filled event that will focus on ***Interprofessional Collaboration and Teamwork*** as it looks at how as health care professions we can respond to public health emergencies as they happen in the communities we serve. The day will focus specifically on wildfires that impacted communities in the Texas Panhandle area in the spring of 2017.

Spring IPE Day will be held on the Abilene, Amarillo, Dallas, Lubbock and Odessa campuses. The event will be hosted from the Lubbock campus and students will participate both through Techlink and with a faculty facilitator leading each team in their assigned rooms. Students participating in Spring IPE Day will be assigned to an interprofessional response team on their campus. Within those teams, students will collaborate together in determining an appropriate plan of action based on the needs of the community while coordinating with other resources with the other various teams. Spring IPE Day is approved through the IPE Registry and all participating students will receive a certificate that can be used towards the IPE curriculum graduation requirements.

Global Health Lecture - Tele-psychiatry Supervision of Mental Health Workers (MHWs) in Liberia

Dr. Ibrahim completed Psychiatry Residency at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai/Elmhurst. He completed a two-year Global Mental Health track during residency. Dr. Ibrahim has published multiple articles and presented in many conferences. His research interests lie in the areas of global mental health, positive psychiatry and medical education. In 2017-2018, the Arnhold Institute for Global Health at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai started a pilot program where 9 senior psychiatry residents offered weekly supervision to MHWs in Liberia. Dr.

Ibrahim will describe the structure and outcome of this program as well as discuss the opportunities and challenges faced by psychiatry residents as well as the MHWs.
