Register today for 2020 Spring IPE Day brought to you by the Office of Interprofessional Education at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center. Spring IPE Day is an excellent way to learn together and practice interprofessional education, teamwork, and collaboration among health care professionals.

Spring IPE Day is a fun-filled event that will focus on *Interprofessional Collaboration and Teamwork* as it looks at how as health care professions we can respond to public health emergencies as they happen in the communities we serve. The day will focus specifically on wildfires that impacted communities in the Texas Panhandle area in the spring of 2017.

Spring IPE Day will be held on the Abilene, Amarillo, Dallas, Lubbock and Odessa campuses. The event will be hosted from the Lubbock campus and students will participate both through Techlink and with a faculty facilitator leading each team in their assigned rooms. Within those teams, students will collaborate together in determining an appropriate plan of action based on the needs of the community while coordinating with other resources with the other various teams.
