Peru June 2020 International Program for Students

Students interested in participating in the TTUHSC Sponsored International Program in Peru this coming June should make note of trip dates and application due date. Additional information about the program, including the application link, has been provided below. All programs are interprofessional. Students from all schools are welcome to apply; however, school/program-specific eligibility requirements do apply.

June 5-14 (1 week) or June 5-18 (2 weeks)

- Application due date: January 15, 4:00 pm CT
- Estimated cost:
 - Clinical Immersion only = \$1,325 (includes accommodations, transportation, supplies for clinic use, administrative fees, & meals) + airfare + most meals
 - Clinical + cultural immersion = an additional \$1,250 + most meals
- Dates:
 - Clinical Immersion only = June 5-14, 2020
 - Clinical + Cultural Immersion (Cusco/Machu Picchu) = June 5-18, 2020
- Faculty leading the program: Julie St. John, DRPH, MPH, MA, CHWI (MPH) and Kendra Thornton, MSN, RN, CA/CP SANE (SON)
- Note: Applicants will be notified of acceptance by February 1. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due from selected participants by February 15.

Spring IPE Day is a fun-filled event that will focus on *Interprofessional Collaboration and Teamwork* as it looks at how as health care professions we can respond to public health emergencies as they happen in the communities we serve. The day will focus specifically on wildfires that impacted communities in the Texas Panhandle area in the spring of 2017.
