

# SGA Meeting Minutes – September 23, 2025

### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by President Sahil Tonk.

# Guest Speaker

- Matt Hernandez, M.Ed., MPH, Senior Director in the Office of the President, presented on university initiatives for first-generation learner achievement.
  - o The initiatives are a direct response to SGA Resolution 2406, which called for comprehensive support programs for first-generation healthcare students.
  - A workgroup has established official definitions for "First-Generation," "First-Generation Post-Baccalaureate," and "First-Health" students to unify data collection and resource allocation.
  - o Mr. Hernandez announced a new scholarship for first-generation students, with applications due October 3rd.
  - He also announced "FIRST at TTUHSC," a month-long celebration in November to support the first-generation community, which will include a micro-credential program titled "First-hand Success Navigator."
  - In response to a question from Faiad Alam regarding the recent loss of federal funding for the "Siempre Adalante" mentorship program, Mr. Hernandez acknowledged the frustration but affirmed the university's unwavering commitment to student achievement and finding new ways to support mentorship initiatives.
