- Lubbock Compact Disparity Report
 - Lubbock Compact focuses on the declining quality of care, security, and safety of "Old Lubbock" (inside of Loop 289)

"Old Lubbock, Lubbock inside of Loop 289, is trapped in decline despite having excellent connectivity and resilient infrastructure based on a simple, but elegant, grid system. The reason it is declining is not because of inherent economic flaws, but that Lubbock's policy orientation is currently shaped to cause its descent."

- People in Lubbock tend to assume that if someone truly needs help, they can get it. BUT THAT'S NOT THE CASE.
- Most important data: Substance use statistics by zip code, by year, by police department
