(Stating the sentiments of the TTUHSC Student Senate congratulating Dr. Zach Sneed, PhD, CRC, LCDC, BC-TMH, FNAP, on his acceptance into the National Academies of Practice as a Distinguished Scholar/Fellow in the Psychology Academy and his work in the TTUHSC School of Health Professions, Master of Science in Addiction Counseling Program)

WHEREAS, Dr. Zach Sneed, PhD, CRC, LCDC, BC-TMH, FNAP, has made significant contributions to the TTUHSC Department of Clinical Counseling and Mental Health, Doctor of Philosophy Addiction Counseling program through his instruction, examination, and advisement; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Sneed serves as an Associate Professor and Assistant Dean for Outcomes and Assessment, providing academic and administrative leadership that supports curriculum quality, program evaluation, and student learning within the School of Health Professions; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Sneed became the founding Program Director of the Master of Science in Addiction Counseling program in 2017 and has played a central role in the development, growth, and academic integrity of the program; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Sneed has been nominated to and accepted into the National Academies of Practice (NAP), a distinguished non-profit organization founded in 1981 to advise governmental bodies on matters related to the United States healthcare system. NAP's membership is composed of practitioners and scholars elected by their peers from multiple health professions. The organization serves as the nation's only interprofessional body dedicated to advancing affordable, accessible, coordinated, and high-quality healthcare for all through collaboration, lifelong learning, and a shared commitment to excellence in interprofessional and preventive care; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Sneed has been accepted as a Distinguished Scholar Fellow, an honor reserved for individuals who have demonstrated exceptional academic achievement through significant and enduring contributions to education and/or research that advance professional practice, and who are recognized by distinguished peers as having made meaningful, lasting impacts within their profession; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Sneed has demonstrated dedication to the Clinical Mental Health Counseling and Addiction Counseling programs at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center through the sharing of his extensive knowledge and expertise, providing instrumental insight into the complexities of substance use disorders, and enhancing student understanding of evidence-based assessment, treatment, and ethical practice in the counseling profession; and therefore,
