1 (Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate regarding amending the SGA Constitution in order  
2 to remove the membership limit placed on the Finance and Scholarship Committees)

4 WHEREAS, the SGA handbook states the Finance and Scholarship Committees “shall be  
5 comprised of 6 individuals, and

7 WHEREAS, the Finance Committee is currently populated by 10 students, and

9 WHEREAS, the Scholarship committee is currently populated by 7 students, and

11 WHEREAS, the Operations, Social, Public Relations, and Community Service committees do  
12 not have a stated membership limit, and

13  
14 WHEREAS, eliminating the limit will allow more diverse and complete Senator representation.

16 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Senate of Texas Tech University Health  
17 Sciences Center should amend the SGA Constitution from stating the Finance and Scholarship  
18 Committees, “shall be comprised of 6 individuals,” to not stating a membership limit for the  
19 Finance and Scholarship Committees.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be spread upon the Journal and that copies
