## 1st Annual West Texas Health Disparities Research Symposium

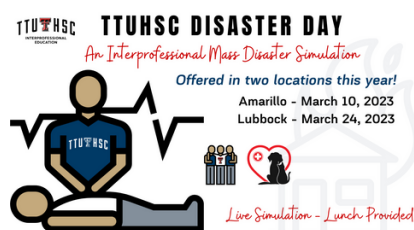

## Black History Month Keynote Address

Alfred and Billie Caviel were the first African-American husband and wife in the United States to own and operate their own pharmacy, in the eastside “Flats” neighborhood of Lubbock, Texas. Caviel’s Pharmacy operated at the corner of Avenue A and 17th Street in Lubbock for 49 years, from the early Civil Rights era in 1960 to 2009.

Billie will provide insight into her experience as it relates to her identity during a tumultuous time for Black health professionals. She will specifically highlight her experience as a resident of Lubbock and the contributions she made to Black history in West Texas.
