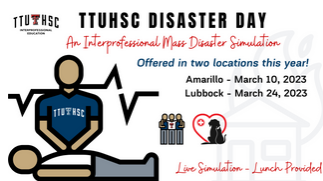
1st Annual West Texas Health Disparities Research Symposium
