Celebration of Life for Dr. Bernhard T. Mittemeyer, who passed away January 25, 2023. Dr. Mittemeyer served TTUHSC for almost 40 years as a physician, professor and administrator. Before joining TTUHSC, he dedicated 28 years to his country, retiring as a lieutenant general in the Army and a highly decorated combat soldier. His military service also included serving as commanding general of the Walter Reed Army Medical Hospital —the highest Army appointment. Yet, above all this, he was a humble servant who greatly valued people and demonstrated that through service to his patients, his university, and his country.
