

## Resiliency in Interprofessional Teamwork

Change is a constant in healthcare. With today's global uncertainty, resiliency, grit, and an understanding of emotional wellness is critical for not only individual success, but team success as well. Join Dr. Michael Gomez, TTUHSC Center for Superheroes, as he shares insight on ways students can adapt in times of difficulty and build resiliency through creative approaches to self and team care.

Following the keynote address, students will participate in interprofessional team discussion identifying action plans that can be put into place that will support resiliency needs from both the individual professional perspective as well as the interprofessional team perspective.

Keynote Title: ***Well Beyond Self-Care: Developing Resilience and Emotional Wellness in Times of Difficulty.***

Michael Gomez, PhD -is a Licensed Psychologist (in both the states of Texas and Oklahoma) and Assistant Professor in the Pediatrics Department of Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center. Dr. Gomez's research interests are child maltreatment, foster children, autism spectrum disorders, and children/adolescents with sexual behavior problems. Dr. Gomez's has been certified as a trainer in numerous specialty areas and is one of a dozen people in the United States who makes up the Trauma and Autism Community of Practice for the NCTSN. He is also one of only a handful of people in the United States trained to assess and differentiate traumatic stress and autism spectrum disorders (ASD) in a formal psychological evaluation.

## New PubMed

The National Library of Medicine has created a newly redesigned interface for PubMed. The new PubMed will become the default for all users on May 18 and will replace the current "legacy" PubMed. The new PubMed features include:

- a Cite feature that allows you to easily generate a properly-styled citation in AMA, APA or NLM citation format
- a Best Match sorting algorithm that brings the most relevant results to the top of your search results
