This free course focuses on how to reduce access to the methods people use to kill themselves. It covers how to: 1) identify people who could benefit from lethal means counseling, 2) ask about their access to lethal methods, and 3) work with them, and their families, to reduce access.

Global Perspectives Film Series: The Truth About Fat


