If you have already setup an outside account but have not submitted the Vendor Setup Forms to our office, please contact us immediately to begin the process of withdrawing your agency funds from TTUHSC.

As a reminder the deadline for moving agency funds to an office campus account is March 1, 2021, to coincide with the annual Student Organization Re-Registration process. This deadline means accounts off-campus have been created and the process for transferring funds has already been started.
