Rural Communities Vaccine Clinics

Accessibility to the COVID-19 vaccine has been difficult for rural communities, and many areas don't have vaccinations to provide residents. To help bridge this need, Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center is partnering with United Supermarkets to deliver the COVID-19 vaccine to local West Texas communities.

At this time, we're looking for TTUHSC students to help administer vaccinations and provide other support at mobile COVID-19 vaccine clinics across West Texas. United Supermarkets is offering three ways for students to participate.

- 1. Contract Worker Immunizers
- 2. Contract Worker (Not Administering Vaccines)
- 3. Student Practicum/Class Credit

Volunteers Needed for Lubbock Vaccine Clinic

To assist in helping our community become vaccinated, TTUHSC is partnering with the City of Lubbock Health Department to staff its public COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center. If interested in assisting with this endeavor, you will be asked to do one of the following jobs:

- **Scribe**: sits beside person administering the vaccination and records name/DOB/time of vaccination.
- Triage: takes person's temperature at front door and questions them about recent illness.
- Crowd/flow control: makes sure the flow of the line moves or doesn't move according to the needs. Directs people where to go next.
- Recovery area: helps sort paperwork in the recovery area based on time they arrived and time they're safe to leave (15 minutes).

Anyone that volunteers will be offered a vaccine, and will receive the vaccine on the day he/she volunteers, if desired. Lunch will be provided by the city to volunteers.
