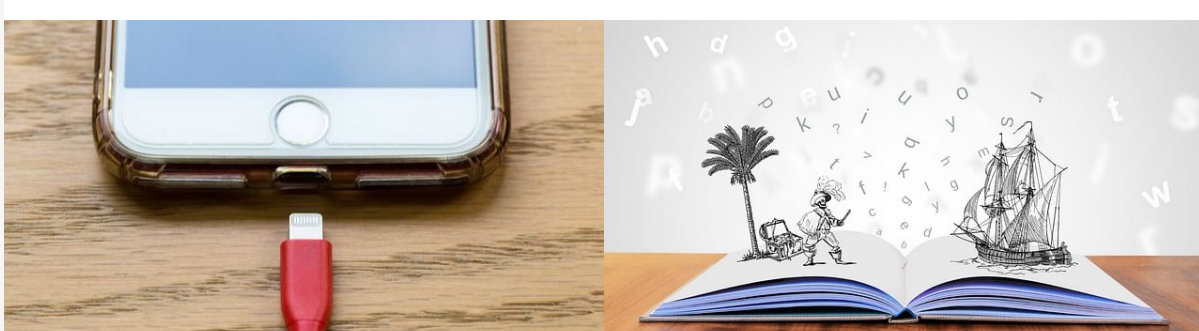


Escape Room Challenge

Recharge at the TTUHSC Libraries

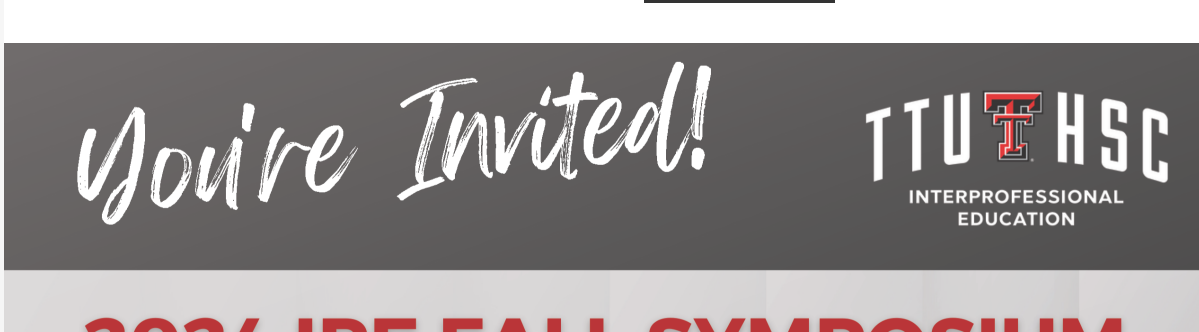

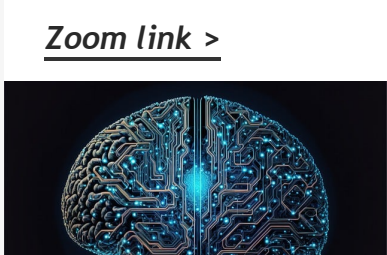
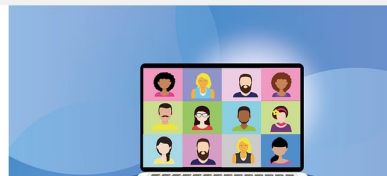

Opening Space Wednesday, September 18 | 12 - 1 pm

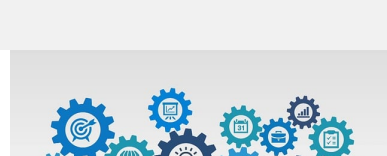

Telehealth at the Crossroads Friday, September 20 | 11 am - 1 pm

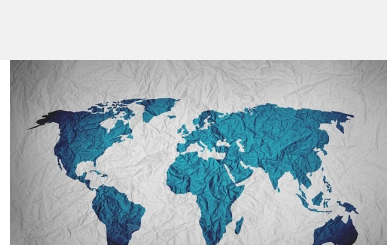
